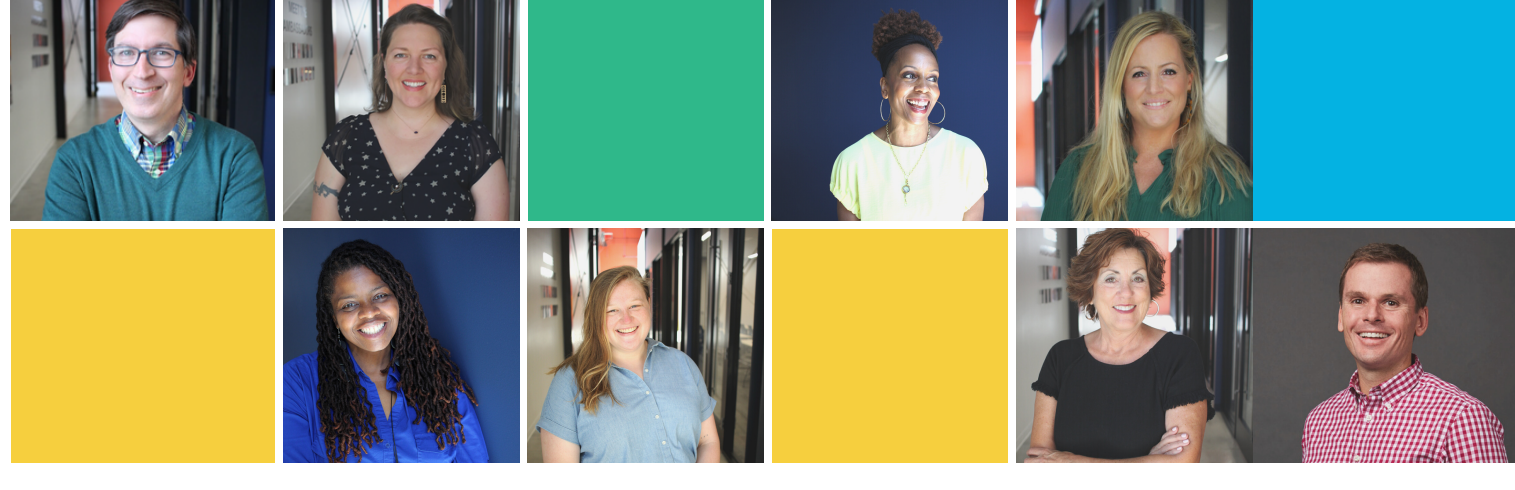


Meet the SparkNC Team

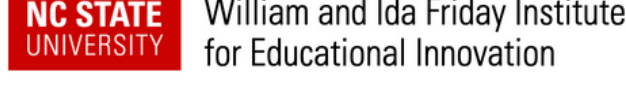
